THE VILLAGES WOMEN'S NINE-HOLE GOLF CLUB CODE OF CONDUCT

The Villages Women's Nine-Hole Golf Club strives to provide a safe and enjoyable experience for members and guests. The goal is to create an environment and culture that is reflective of the personal integrity and respect taught in the Rules of Golf. This same integrity, honesty and good-will are expected on the golf course, the clubhouse or in resolving any dispute while at The Villages or representing The Villages.

When the conduct of any member has been so contrary to these principles and has endangered or is likely to endanger the welfare, interest or good character of The Villages, The Villages Women's Nine-Hole Golf Club Board of Directors or Handicap Committee may, after review, take disciplinary action which may include oral or written warning, suspension, expulsion or recommendation to the USGA to with Handicap Index.

Acts that would violate the Code of Conduct:

- Deliberately breaks a rule of the Association or the Rules of Golf to cheat or gain benefit.
- Deliberately returns a false scorecard.
- Behaves in a manner detrimental to the good name and reputation of The Villages Women's Nine-Hole Golf Club at The Villages or while representing the Club at other courses.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct or using abusive language.
