

SWINGERS' MEMBERSHIP CLASSIFICATIONS

Primary Membership – Primary members are women who have qualified as per Section 2. of the Standard Operating Policies and have an 18-hole handicap, which was established on a regulation 9 or 18-hole golf course. This designation is established by which group is joined first.

Dual Membership – Women who are a member of The Villages Women's 18-Hole Club or The Villages Short-9 Club who have qualified as per Section 2. of the Swingers' Standard Operating Policies and have an established 18-hole USGA handicap index not higher than 38.5 equivalent to an Association handicap of 40 or lower from the 3/2 Combo Tees are eligible to qualify for Dual Membership and participate in both the 9-hole and 18-hole play days.

1. Dual Members must <u>annually</u> designate which group, 9-hole, 18-hole, or short-9, is their Primary Club. The other group will become their Dual Membership. <u>Membership</u> type may be changed once annually at the beginning of the calendar year.

Social Membership

- 1. Membership will be open to women who have been Primary or Dual members in good standing of the Swingers and who no longer wish to play golf or participate in weekly sweeps or other golf events.
- 2. Social Members may join all social functions and Board Meetings but will not be eligible for privileges of regular members
- 3. Social Members only need to declare to the Membership Director that they wish to change to this type of membership.

Associate Membership

- 1. Membership will be open to women who have been Primary or Dual members in good standing of the Swingers and who desire to play on Tuesday mornings, however, they no longer desire to maintain a USGA/NCGA handicap*, participate in weekly sweeps, Captain's Trophy Tournaments, Twilight Tournaments and Exchanges.
- 2. Members may switch to an Associate Member effective at the beginning of the calendar year by advising the Membership Director. Associate Members wishing to rejoin the Swingers as full participants will need to pay the same fees as new members.
- 3. Associate Members are not eligible to hold elective office or vote.
- * Associate members can keep their NCGA membership, however, they will need to post their own scores and pay the dues separately from the Swingers.
